

Tony Lubiniecki, ScD (USA)

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Anthony S. Lubiniecki, is a biotechnologist presently employed by Janssen Pharmaceuticals of Johnson & Johnson. He has served as a PhRMA representative to the International Conferences on Harmonization (ICH) Expert Working Groups on biotechnology product quality, producing 6 guidance documents.

During his 35 years in industry, he has worked on the development of 30 recombinant derived investigational products, using both microbial and eukaryotic expression systems, of which 8 have become marketed products. He is Adjunct Professor of Chemical and Biochemical Engineering at the University of Maryland, Baltimore County, a post he has held since 1991. He is also a member of the National Research Council Standing Committee on the Department of Defense's Programs to Counter Biological Threats.

He earned his Doctor of Science degree in Public Health Microbiology from the University of Pittsburgh in 1972.
