John Petricciani is immediate past president of the International Alliance for Biological Standardization (IABS), a non-profit organization devoted to scientific and medical advancement of biologicals. He also serves on the World Health Organization (WHO) Expert Panel on Biologicals, is an adjunct staff member at the John Wayne Cancer Institute, and is an honorary professor of the Institute of Medical Biology at the Chinese Academy of Medical Sciences, China.

Dr. Petricciani currently is licensed to practice medicine in California and Washington, D.C., and has held senior research, medical, and administrative positions in the public and private sectors, including Genetics Institute and the WHO, where he was the chief medical officer of the Biologicals unit. Dr. Petricciani also previously served as the director of the Office of Biologics at the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA).

Dr. Petricciani received a bachelor of science in chemistry from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, a master of science in chemistry from the University of Nevada, and a doctorate in medicine (MD) from Stanford University. He is a fellow of the Royal Society of Medicine (UK) and has authored or co-authored more than 160 articles on tumor cell assays, cytogenetics, and regulatory policy.
