Elwyn Griffiths' vast experience of research and regulatory issues in biologicals stems from his time on the staff of the MRC National Institute for Medical Research, London (1969-80) and at the National Institute for Biological Standards and Control, UK (1980-94). His next post was Chief, Biologicals, at the WHO, Geneva, where he was responsible for their international programme in biological standardization of vaccines, blood products and biotherapeutics, including gene therapy products. In 2003, he joined BGTD, Health Canada, Ottawa, which has regulatory oversight of biologicals in Canada.

Over many years he has contributed to numerous Canadian, UK, European and WHO committees and also to working groups concerned with the quality, safety and efficacy of biologicals. A longstanding member of the IABS, he is a former Editor In Chief of Biologicals as well as co-organizer of several IABS meetings.
